It is a condition of entry and admission to the venue that all competitors and visitors comply with the reasonable requests of the Tournament Organiser and Judge in Charge for the safety and comfort of all persons attending.

GNAS dress regulations 307 will apply.

Photography & image recording - the recommendation in the GNAS Protection of Children & Vulnerable Adults Policy will apply. All persons wishing to make recorded images or video have to register with the tournament organiser.

This Record Status Shoot will be liable for drug testing; competitors approached to give samples must comply, as refusal will be treated as a positive result. Parents or carers of competitors under the age of 18 must sign the Entry Form giving consent to a drug test if required.

Archery GB Membership cards to be shown on registration, competitors may only shoot with proof of membership.
